Attendance taken and a quorum were declared.

Signed check manifest in the amount of \$7,843.17 for 30 September 2013.

Loretta Loring came in to get and received approval from the Select board pending checking into our insurance coverage, to take advantage of the Town of Newport's offer to loan Marlow an Ambulance while ours is in for service.

Brian Sharkey MM, Assistant Director of Field Services for Boy Scouts came in to explain what their youth firefighter "Explorer" program involves:

- Insurance coverage for youths and adults, liability coverage.
- Protocol, all participants fill out an application. Adults have background checks etc in order to get insurance coverage, youths complete application.
- Link to www.learningforlife.com describes actual training.
- 40 towns in NH are participating in this program.
- It is a career mentoring program.
- Leader training and certification as a prerequisite, renew every two years along with training of youth advisors.
- Start with open house, would typically meet weekly and should have a three month schedule in advance.

Selectmen are supportive of a youth program that insures the safety of the participants.
