

SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES FOR MAY 12, 2014

Attendance taken and a quorum was declared.

Selectmen signed a check manifest in the amount of \$5,267.33 for the week of 5/12/14.

Lyle Handy brought in a copy of an existing right of way agreement to allow better access to the newly acquired Cohen properties.

Selectmen reviewed a proposal from Primex for the following coverage's.

- Property Liability
- Workers Compensation
- Unemployment Compensation

These policies are currently with the Local Government Center, The Selectmen reviewed the services provided by both and decided to move these policies to Primex. Health Insurance policies will remain with the LGC. This change should result in a significant reduction in premiums.

John Mann came in to update the Board on progress he has made on the following items he is helping to research at the State level.

- LGC rebate

Ken Avery came in to let us know that he has coordinated with the Highway Department with individual who is providing some community service work for the Town.

Selectmen reviewed and signed Bank reconciliation statements.

Selectmen signed Purchase order to the Keene Sentinel publishing in the amount of 180.00 for tax bill forms to be printed.

Selectmen reviewed end of year report on power produced @ the Marlow Hydro facility in keeping with the Pilot program.
