

## **SELECTMEN'S MINUTES FOR 7 NOVEMBER 2016**

Attendees: Barry Corriveau, Tom Fuschetto, Bob Allen & Jacqui Fay.

Attendance taken and a quorum was declared.

Reviewed deposits and signed check manifest in the amount of \$24,272.02.

Asked if there were any questions from the floor. Judi Ryner asked if the ATV Club had submitted a revised trail proposal. Replied that we had not seen one yet. Also asked if we had received any further information on reducing the speed limit in the village district. Replied that we were looking into a traffic engineering firm that would be recognized by the State DOT.

Curtis White got sworn in as Planning Board alternate member.

Reviewed letter dated 7 November from NH Homeland Security and Emergency Management informing Town that State Emergency Operations Center will be open for duration of voting tomorrow and urging public safety officials to exercise extra vigilance.

Update on Marlow Hill. 30% of base gravel and under drains and all new culverts have been installed. Final negotiations on contract this week.

Have not received any response from Merrimack Superior Court regarding Town affidavit that was filed with them.

Reviewed letter dated November 2 from NHDOT enclosing signed Temporary Use Agreement received for kiosk. Signed check to go with application for Shoreland Permit by Notification. Waiting to receive signed application from NHDOT.

Reviewed Police Log.

Reviewed letter dated October 24 from Town of Gilsum confirming that they have entered into an agreement with a local full time ambulance service for their needs. Town will be sending a letter requesting to attend the Town of Alstead, Selectboard meeting to discuss possibility of joint venture with regards to ambulance service.

Selectmen discussed coverage for tomorrow's elections.

Reviewed email dated 29 October from Stephanie Tickner forwarding suggestion from Diane Rota's that link to Community website be added to official website. Will check with website provider, previously advised that if we provide a link to a non-official website we are obliged to provide links to all others that are requested.

Reviewed email dated November 4 from CCI Managed ref cyber security, advised that we do not need to take out additional insurance.

Reviewed letter ref permit application dated November 2 from NHDES Map 406 Lot 049.

Reviewed new overtime rules that come into effect 12/1/2016.

Barry updated board on his research into microphones. Staples unable to give him any advice. Will continue to pursue.

Reviewed NHDES Official List of Public Waters. Will contact NH Fish and Game to see which water bodies in Marlow they regulate.

Reviewed Sales Analysis.

Reviewed Trustees reports for October.

Reviewed email dated November 4 from Maria Baril requesting approval to purchase 3 wreaths for Town buildings. Approved up to a total limit of \$100.

Research shown that any petition to change use of Class 5 roads can only be advisory.

Reviewed email dated November 4 from Ken Dassau ref election signs, reminding that signs cannot be placed on public property.

Reviewed email dated November 4 from Wendy Pelletier with 2 estimates for surveying. Agreed to go ahead with survey for Map 407 Lot 033. Hole in the roof has been repaired.

Judi Ryner asked what the process was for requesting a Special Town Meeting to address the issue of ATV's on Class V roads. She was informed that would be redundant because we are required to hold a public hearing for any change of use of Class V roads per NH RSA's.
